With the enactment of the Sri Lanka Electricity Act No. 20 of 2009, the Commission became the economic, safety and technical regulator of the Electricity industry.

Applications are invited from qualified candidates to fill the following vacant positions of the Commission.

1) Assistant Director Legal-01 position (On contract)

- a) Reporting relationship

- b) Objective of the position:
To aid and render legal support in all day to day operations.
- c) Qualification
 - Attorney-at-Law and Notary Public with the license to practice in both Sinhala and English languages
- d) Experience
 - Should possess minimum three (03) years of experience in handling all types of legal work including drafting legal documents, contracts and agreements and appearing in court cases.
