POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA LEADING TO M.Sc. IN ARCHITECTURAL CONSERVATION OF MONUMENTS & SITES

The Department of Architecture, University of Moratuwa is pleased to announce the commencement of the Postgraduate programme in Architectural Conservation of Monuments & Sites for the academic year 2020/2021 and invites applications for admission from suitably qualified candidates.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

(i) The Honours Degree of Bachelor of Architecture of the University of Moratuwa or an equivalent degree from a University acceptable to the Senate on the recommendation of the Faculty Board of Architecture.

OR

(ii) The Degree of Bachelor of Science in Built Environment of the University of Moratuwa or an equivalent degree from a university acceptable to the Senate on the recommendation of the Faculty Board of Architecture and at least two (02) years of relevant experience after obtaining the Degree.

OR

- (iii) One of the following Honours Degrees from the University of Moratuwa or an equivalent degree from a university acceptable to the Senate on the recommendation of the Faculty Board of Architecture and at least one (01) year of relevant experience after obtaining the Degree.
 - a) Bachelor of Landscape Architecture
 - b) Bachelor of Design
 - c) Bachelor of Science in Town and Country Planning
 - d) Bachelor of Science in Quantity Surveying
 - e) Bachelor of Science in Facilities Management
 - f) Bachelor of Science of Engineering

OR

- (iv) One of the following Degrees from a university acceptable to the Senate on the recommendation of the Faculty Board of Architecture and at least one (01) year of relevant experience after obtaining the Degree.
 - a) Bachelor of Arts with subjects/modules in the field of Archeology
 - b) Bachelor of Fine Arts
 - c) Bachelor of Science in Physical Science
 - d) Bachelor of Science in Bio Science
 - Bachelor of Arts in Fine Arts

OR

(v) The Corporate membership of the Sri Lanka Institute of Architects or the Corporate membership of the Institute of Town Planners Sri Lanka and at least one (01) year relevant experience after obtaining the said membership.

PROGRAMME OF STUDIES

a) Postgraduate Diploma in Architectural Conservation of Monuments & Sites:

Duration - One year taught courses plus studio works, assignments, seminars and field visits. All academic work will normally be conducted on Fridays and Saturdays.

b) M.Sc. in Architectural Conservation of Monuments & Sites:

Duration - Two Years same curriculum as for the Postgraduate Diploma plus a Conservation Project and a Dissertation.

COURSE FEES (FOR LOCAL CANDIDATES)

Registration Fee : Rs. 1,000 per year

Examination Fee : Rs. 1,000 per year (payable at registration)

Tuition Fees : Rs. 125,000 for the first year (PG Diploma) and additional Rs. 80,000 for the second year (M.Sc. in ACOMAS)

Library Deposit : Rs. 2,500 per item, up to 6 items (Optional and refundable)
