WHY?

Possessing an ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organization) recognized qualification is an advantage for you to be employed at any international airport. After completion of training you will be eligible to be absorbed to the AASL permanent cadre subject to availability of vacancies.

How?

The applicants are required to undergo a standard medical test and physical fitness test. The selectees will receive training in 2 stages.

WHAT?

We are looking for energetic Ex-serviceman, who possess required qualifications to undergo training in Airport Fire & Rescue training at Bandaranaike International Airport (BIA) at Katunayake and Civil Aviation Training Centre (CATC) at Ratmalana, with the aim of paving a path to them to become professionals in AFRS.

STAGE 01

Fire & Rescue Trainee

ICAO Standard Training Program (03 Months Residential Course)

- Those who are selectees at the final examination of **STAGE 01** are eligible to follow **STAGE 02**.
- Bond should be signed by the trainee at the start of the Training Programme.

STAGE 02

Trainee Airport Fire Fighter

On the Job Training at BIA (1 year)

- Trainees will be deployed at BIA to undergo Fire operational training with uniforms.
- Continuation Training Programs (04 classes per month) is mandatory for them.
- They will be paid a training allowance of Rs.40,000/= per month for 12 months.

Those who have successfully completed training will be absorbed into the permanent cadre as Airport Fire Fighter Gr. II.

YOUR SUITABILITY

- Should have passed the GCE (O/L) examination with Credit passes for English Language and Mathematics with a simple pass for Science.
- Preference will be given to those who have passed the GCE (A/L) examination in 03 subjects.
- Fluency in Spoken English.
- Age below 43 years.
- Should possess 10 years continuous satisfactory service in the Military or Police Service.
- Minimum height 66" and weight 56 kg
- Male candidates only.
