Calling Applications for the Post of Research Fellow

The NCAS is a National Centre in Sri Lanka set up by Ordinance No. 02 of 2005 under Section 24A of the Universities Act No. 16 of 1978 for the purpose of promoting advanced studies and research in the fields of Humanities and Social Sciences.

Applications are invited from eligible, motivated and dedicated academics employed at the Universities and other Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) set up under the aforesaid University Act for the Post of Research Fellow at the NCAS.

Qualifications/experience and other requirements:

- possess a PhD in a field falling under Humanities or Social Sciences;
- be currently employed in the position of Senior Lecturer Grade 1 or above in a University or HEI operating under the University Grants Commission;
- be entitled to sabbatical leave for a minimum period of one (01) year;
- have a good track record in research and publications;
- demonstrate a good knowledge in alternative paradigms of research in Humanities and Social Sciences;
- Possess workable experience in coordinating workshops, conference, seminar, etc.
- possess excellent interpersonal and communication skills (both oral and written) in English;

In addition to the above, the prospective candidates are required to submit a well-articulated proposal specifying the research/ project that she/he intends to implement during her/his affiliation with the NCAS as a Research Fellow.

Age limit: Below 60 years on the last date of application.

The appointment: Appointment shall be made on contract basis for a period of one year and attractive monthly allowance will be paid to the appointee.

Application with complete bio-data, research proposal, and supporting evidence **along with the recommendation of the Head, Dean and the approval of Vice Chancellor that you will be released on available sabbatical leave for the particular period if you are selected**, must reach undersigned on **or before 15th May 2024**. Words "Post of Research Fellow" should be indicated on the top left hand corner of the envelope. Your Biodata must include personal details, work experience, academic and research credentials Copies of the best three publications throughout the candidate's career and best three publications during the last five year period should be inserted with the application. The shortlisted candidates will be informed through e-mail to appear for an interview on a date specified later.
