

<u>Recruitment to the Post of Human Rights Officer – III – 2024</u> <u>Human Rights Commission of Sri Lanka</u>

The Human Rights Commission of Sri Lanka invites applications from government servants currently in permanent government service for the permanent position of Human Rights Officer - III.

Conditions of Employment:

This is a permanent position with contributions to the Employees' Provident Fund and Employees' Trust Fund.

Qualifications:

- 1. Bachelor's Degree in Law, Social Sciences, Conflict Resolution, International Relations, or related subjects from a university recognized by the University Grants Commission, and a Post Graduate Diploma in the relevant field.
- 2. Age must not exceed 45 years as of the application receipt date.
- 3. Must possess excellent character.
- 4. Must have the physical and mental fitness to work in any position in Sri Lanka.

Salary Scale:

Additionally, a 25% allowance of the basic salary and a cost of living allowance are provided.

Recruitment Procedure:

• Suitable candidates will be selected through a structured interview based on the following criteria:

- 30 marks

- 25 marks

• Priority for selection will be determined by the marks obtained in the interview, the position requested by the applicant, and the number of vacancies (according to the medium of language).
