 field measurements and records, and by cross-referencing rates with quotation or
 agreement documents. Recommend payments to contractors and service providers after
 inspecting completed works and services, considering the complexity and number of items
 in the invoice, to prevent any payment delays.
- Complete estimation work listed in Capital Expenditure Applications (CEA's) and work request received from other departments to raise CEA's meeting timelines.
- Advise evaluation committees about market prices of services and answer cost related quarries raised by them.
- Assist sectional managers decisions in carrying out negotiations with contractors on their quotations/Bids and be an evaluation committee member for all quotations raised in the department.
- Preparation of civil, electrical and mechanical engineering, civil structural and architectural drawings requested by the colleagues of Properties department meeting timelines without affecting the project schedules.
- Revise and maintain architectural, structural, Service, Civil, Electrical and mechanical asbuilt drawings with proper coding system for easy retrieval.
