- Maintain zero-tolerance with respect to adherence to all internal audit, external audit & regulatory compliance, as applicable

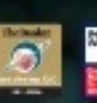
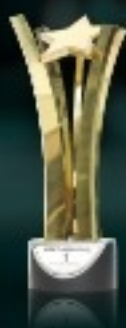
