Background of the project:

National Cancer Control Program (NCCP) invites application from eligible candidates for the post of Research Assistant for a research project on "Psycho social needs and psychological distress of the primary caregivers of children & adolescents with cancers, at National Cancer Institute, Maharagama and the impact of an intervention to address their emotional and informational needs".
