- (iii) Experience in addressing climate change issues in the context of value chain development.
- (iv) Demonstrated experience in designing and facilitating tools and trainings on following categories, "Agricultural environmental impact mitigation, water management, Agro chemical usage, environmental assessment, cleaner production and pollution abatement, solid waste management, air pollution control and reduction etc"
- (v) Experience in similar assignments in donor funded projects will have an advantage

- (vii) Ability to work in other local languages would also be considered advantageous
- (viii) High degree of independence, flexibility and ability to meet strict deadlines

- (ii) A minimum of seven years progressive experience in finance in agriculture systems, micro-finance and banking, ideally with some management responsibility.
- (iii) Demonstrated experience in addressing inclusive finance issues in the context of rural development and poverty alleviation.
- (iv) Experience in designing, delivering and facilitating tools and trainings on inclusive finance, developing and/or marketing microfinance lending products, particularly for youth and women and in the agriculture sector.
- (v) Experience in similar assignments in donor funded projects will have an advantage
- (vi) Working knowledge of spoken and written English and ability to work independently in Microsoft Office Packages
- (vii) Ability to work in other local languages would also be considered advantageous
- (viii) High degree of independence, flexibility and ability to meet strict deadlines
