One research assistant will be recruited for completing 450 interviews (baseline and follow - ups).

to collect data through interviews and to follow up the participants at their residences or

respective clinics.

Recruited Research Assistant will be trained on data collection before commencing activities.

NCD unit will take final decision on recruiting the eligible applicant.

Qualification:

Applicants should hold a medical degree (MBBS or equivalent) awarded by a local or foreign

medical institution recognized by the University Grant Commission. No experienced is required.

Age:

There is no age limit. However, preference will be given to those age is not more than 35 years

at the date of closure of applications.

Five hundred rupees (Rs: 500) will be paid per one completed set of questionnaires with

maximum of thirty five thousand rupees (Rs: 35,000) per month.
